WHAT IS 'CELEBRATE ON THE SQUARE'?

The United Nations-sanctioned International Day of People with Disability is held on 3 December each year.

This year, 3 December falls on a Sunday, so we are holding our celebration on Friday, 1 December.

International Day of People with Disability is a world-wide celebration to raise public awareness of people living with disability and to recognise and acknowledge their contributions and achievements.

In South Australia, we will host an event as a part of International Day of People with Disability called 'Celebrate on the Square', which will celebrate the achievements of people with disability and show the community what our organisations deliver.
